**Analysis shows Pupil Premium children performing in line with non Pupil Premium children by the end of Key Stage 2**

70% of children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved Expected Level or above in all 5 subjects (28% in 2018)

22% of children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved Expected Level or above in 4 subjects. (30% in 2018)

15% of children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved Expected Level or above in 3 subjects. (34% in 2018)

11% of children eligible for Pupil Premium achieved Expected Level or above in 2 subjects. (38% in 2018)

74% of children eligible for Pupil Premium gained GDS in at least 1 subject. (63% in 2018)

48% of children eligible for Pupil Premium gained GDS in at least 2 subjects. (37% in 2018)

26% of children eligible for Pupil Premium gained GDS in at least 3 subjects. (21% in 2018)

4% of children eligible for Pupil Premium gained GDS in 4 subjects. (11% in 2018)
